#### SETTING THE STAGE

The first men's basketball season at SIUE was 1967-68 under Coach Harry Gallatin, who is a member of the Basketball Hall of Fame as well as SIUE's first director of athletics. SIUE is in year one of reclassification to NCAA Division I competition in all sports. On July 1, SIUE announced it would become the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference and will begin league play in 2011-12.

#### NATIONAL CHAMPIONS

SIUE has won 17 national championships in five different sports in its history. All but one national title is at the NCAA Division II level. The 1979 men's soccer national title was at the Division I level. SIUE has won seven Division

II men's tennis titles (1978, 1979, 1980, 1981, 1982, 1983), four in women's tennis (1986, 1987, 1988, 1989), three in wrestling (1984, 1985, 1986), two in men's soccer (1972, 1979) and one in softball (2007).

#### ON THE RADIO

Joe Pott will be providing the play-by-play for Cougar basketball all season. The Cougars can be heard on WSIE FM 88.7 and KFNS AM 590 "The Fan" and on the web at www.kfns.com.

#### SIUE'S RENOVATION

SIUE is completing renovation on its home, the Vadalabene Center. The renovation includes three times as many chairback seats as well as expanded restrooms, storage and office space. The main court already has seen a handful of volleyball matches and three preseason basketball contests.

#### ELITE EIGHT

SIUE has attended the NCAA Tournament five times in its history. SIUE advanced to the Division II Elite Eight during the 2005-06 season. The tournament was held in Springfield, Mass., home of the Basketball Hall of Fame.

### OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE

SIUE officially joined the Ohio Valley Conference as its lone non-football school back on July 1. The OVC announced that all SIUE team sports will begin regular season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13.

### VICTORY NO. 1

SIUE, 1-2 at the Charleston Classic, outscored its opponents cumulatively with an 11-point win over Western Michigan coupled with a three-point loss to East Tennessee State and a six-point loss to College of Charleston. The Cougars then lost 88-58 with a capacity crowd at Wisconsin's Kohl Arena.

### ON THE ROSTER - NOT FORGOTTEN

Brandon Dunson is a transfer from Tennessee-Chattanooga. He is eligible for play after the completion of the first semester due to the Division I transfer rule. That rule also applies to No. 24 David Boarden, who is sitting out the 2008-09 season after transferring from the University of Detroit. The Cougars also announced the freshman Desmond Young would sit out the season as a redshirt.

### FIRST MEETING

This is the first meeting between SIUE and BSU.

### MISSING AND NOT FORGOTTEN

Freshman Mark Yelovich was the team's leading scorer and was out of the lineup against Wisconsin due to a sudden family emergency.

### BEEF WELLINGTON

Barry Wellington is the only player who has scored double digits in each of the first four games. He was the leading scorer for the first time this season in the loss to Wisconsin.

### ON THE FREE THROW LINE

The free throw line has not been a friend to SIUE's opponents through three games. Opponents are

shooting 52 of 92 (56.5 percent) from the line. SIUE, conversely, has hit 71.7 percent of its free throws.

### THE DIVISION I SCHEDULE

Coach Forrester has signed the Cougars on to play 15 games against NCAA Division I opponents plus home-and-away regular season games against Seattle, North Dakota, and South Dakota. Those three schools also are in the same year of reclassification to Division I as the Cougars.

### SENIOR LEADERSHIP

Springfield native John Edmison is the team's leading rebounder with 22 rebounds in four games.

### I CAN SEE MCCLEARY NOW

Aamir McCleary was one of the top players in assists at the Charleston Classi, leading all eight teams after two complete games. He has 15 assists through three games. McCleary also hit a key three-pointer that put SIUE up by 11 with 2:11 to play in the win over Western Michigan.

### IN THE POST

SIUE's post players are putting up some interesting numbers. Sophomore Nikola Bundalo has hit 63.6 percent of his shots while freshman Terrance Williams holds a 61.5 percent field goal percentage.

### ROAD WARRIORS

Welcome to Division I. It's a common phrase around the SIUE Athletics Department. The Cougars will certainly get their fill of Division I this season. SIUE plays in 10 different states: Illinois, South Carolina, Wisconsin, Indiana, Tennessee, Missouri, Iowa, Washington, South Dakota and North Dakota.

## Coach Lennox Forrester

### COACH

#### LENNOX FORRESTER

Lennox Forrester put his mark on SIUE basketball in his first season, setting the school record for wins by a first-year head coach. With a 17-11 mark, SIUE qualified for the postseason and put the Cougars into a position to make a smooth transition to NCAA Division I play.



Forrester looks to build on the foundation he set in year one. He immediately set his game plan into motion during the 2007-08 season. Forrester led the Cougars to becoming a top defensive team. The Cougars limited their opponents to shooting 43 percent from the field, strong enough for second in the conference. The Cougars were also second in the conference with their 7.96 steal per game average. Within that framework, SIUE basketball was motivated to becoming a strong presence on the offensive end, dangerous with an inside and outside game.

Forrester also coached T.J. Gray into becoming an All-GLVC second team selection. The Chicago native was tops in the conference with his 3.78 three pointers made per game. Gray became the SIUE all-time season leader for three pointers with 102.

Introduced as SIUE's seventh head coach on April 9, 2007, Forrester quickly proved that he had all of the tools necessary to provide a successful program on the court and in the classroom.

He came to SIUE as one of the longest-tenured assistant coaches in the Missouri Valley Conference, last spending five seasons as an assistant coach for Bradley University. Forrester made a name for himself by working his way from former player to trusted assistant coach. To earn that trust, Forrester gained experience in every facet of the coaching ranks from recruiting to day-to-day operations to on-court teaching.

His work with post players and perimeter players at Bradley proved successful for the Braves.

Forrester was beside Bradley Coach Jim Les when the Braves advanced to the second round of the Mastercard NIT last season. The 2005-06 season also saw the Braves advance to the NCAA Tournament's Sweet Sixteen. Forrester also spent 10 seasons (1992-2002) as an assistant coach and an administrative assistant for the University of Evansville under Coach Jim Crews.

A former National Junior College All-American at Parkland College in 1989, Forrester transferred to Evansville to join the Purple Aces as a player. Leg injuries precluded Forrester from playing. Instead, he remained with the program as a student assistant.

Forrester earned a bachelor of arts in sociology at Evansville in 1992. He was a junior college All-American at Parkland College before transferring to Evansville. He and his wife, Aretha, have a 4-year-old daughter, Calaya.
