Enterprise Rent-A-Car Student Organization Leader of the Semester Award

Award Criteria

- Students shall be nominated by their organization(s).
 - Criteria for consideration include:
 - participation and attendance at events and meetings (consider quantity and quality of participation)
 - willingness to take on responsibility
 - organizing skills; effectiveness at involving others in the organization
 - doing things that bring positive attention to the organization
 - helped the organization by bringing some new or innovative idea to the organization
 - student must be in good academic standing (not on probation)
- Candidates may be nominated on performance during any period of Academic Year 2010-2011.

Selection Committee

- Student organization advisors
- Representative from Enterprise Rent-A-Car

Selection Process

- Each organization submits a written or electronic application form to Lindsey Conner, Program Manager at lconner@siue.edu by noon on March 11, 2011 for Spring Semester.
- Applications are reviewed by the selection committee.
- Selection Committee votes by email on a winner for each semester.
- Winner is the nominee with most votes (simple count). In the event of a tie, Selection Committee votes on nominees tied with highest vote count. In the event of a second tie, both students will receive the award.

Recognition

- Each student winner will receive a certificate and a \$100 award.
- A news release will be sent to the *Alestle*.
- The student winner will be featured on the Business Student Information Center "Announcement" board.
- The award winner will be introduced at a faculty meeting.
- The award will be made by representatives from Enterprise Rent-A-Car.
- All award winners will be recognized at the Enterprise Rent-A-Car Student Organization Recognition Program in April



Enterprise Rent-A-Car Student Organization Award

Award Criteria

The award recognizes that student organizations have different missions and that those different missions add to the vitality and quality of education in the School of Business. The award will be made to the organization which is judged to:

- demonstrate how its activities support the accomplishment of the organization's mission;
- demonstrate how its activities accomplish the organization's stated goals; and
- demonstrate how its members serve the organization and how the organization serves its stakeholders.

Examples of organizational activities and goal accomplishment may include but are not limited to collaboration with other organizations, increasing awareness of the organization and its mission, enhancing organizational growth, and service to the community.

Selection Committee

- Department chairs;
- Associate dean for academic affairs;
- one member of School of Business Advisory Board;
- one member of School of Business Alumni Board;
- one representative from SIUE Division of Student Affairs;
- one representative from Enterprise Rent-A-Car.

Selection Process

School of Business Student Organizations shall submit a nomination document by March 11, 2011, that includes:

- examples of activities that support the organization's mission;
- examples of how the organization accomplishes its stated goals; and
- ways members serve the organization and specific ways that the organization serves its stakeholders.

The Selection Committee will meet in early March to review nomination forms and to decide on the winning organization.

Recognition

- The organization winner will be announced at the Enterprise Rent-A-Car Student Organization Recognition Program in April.
- The first place organization winner will receive \$1,000, second place will receive \$750, and third place will receive \$250.
- A news release will be sent to the *Alestle* and local media.
- The organization will be featured on Business Student Information Center "Announcement" board.
